

# No 5 1/2 Wide Jack

This is the ideal plane to use for initial preparation of wide boards, particularly when there is a lot of work to do and the added weight of a No 6 would be unwelcome.

As with all Clifton woodworking tools, the No 4 is an accurate and smoothly functioning tool aimed at the discerning cabinet maker and woodworker.

The plane itself requires no flattening or fettling in prior to use, although the most users prefer to hone the blade themselves to their preferred cutting angle.

The Body and Frog are machined from grey cast iron, in the traditional "Bedrock" manner. The handle and knob are bubinga. The 2" blade is forged from high carbon steel, hardened to Rockwell 60-62. The cap iron is Clifton's two-piece design, the adjuster and lever clamp are solid polished brass.

\*\*\* Due to a recent change of ownership, Clifton are changing the colour of the plane livery. The colour "graphite" is replacing the familiar green that we are used to. We will update the images on the website as soon as we are able to. Customers that receive a plane in the new colour need not worry, as nothing else is changing.
