Hardener

Treatex® hardener is a chemical additive that can be used in commercial locations to increase surface hardness by at least 10% by mixing 10% hardener to Treatex® Hardwax oil. Can be used in both coats or just top coat if required.

Oily / Dense Timbers

Use Treatex® Isoparaffin when treating oily/dense timbers e.g. Iroko, Ipe, Teak, Jarrah, Merbau etc. Treatex® Isoparaffin is used to thin Treatex® Hardwax Oil Traditional so that it can properly penetrate into oily and dense timbers. For the first coat mix approximately 10% Treatex® Isoparaffin with Treatex® Hardwax Oil Traditional.
